# **Qualification requirements**

An individual or a team consisting of student representative from universities (undergraduates / graduate students or postdoctoral fellows) in Tokai area (Aichi / Gifu / Mie prefecture) and Osaka University.

#### Application procedure

- 2. Prepare 3 minutes presentation for pre-selection

# About activity support fund

Use the funds effectively for entrepreneurial activities and submit (1) activity report and (2) accounting report.

Prior to the grant of the fund, we ask you to submit a commitment form.

We assume that the following are the example of usage. For other uses, please contact the Tongali Project Secretariat.



- 1. Survey costs
- 2. Advertising and public relation expenses
- 3. Consumables, communication, transportation, rent, travel, utility water, printing, materials
- 4. Expenses required for purchasing and repairing machinery and tools necessary for establishment
- 5. Expenses required to acquire program usage rights
- 6. Raw material costs for business promotion
- 7. Subcontract processing cost

#### **Others**

You may be required to return part or all of the fund if any of the following apply:

- 1. When you became non-student.
- 2. When disciplinary action is taken in accordance with the punishment provisions of the university you belong to.
- 3. When reporting duties (activity report, financial report) are not fulfilled.
- 4. When entrepreneurial activities are suspended due to injury or other reasons.
- 5. When the planned entrepreneurial activities is significantly delayed.
- 6. In addition, when it is judged to be significantly contradict to the purpose of the fund.
